- 2 The Teahouse at Abkhazi Garden

While visiting the gardens, stop at the Teahouse for Afternoon Tea or "Elevenes". Open 11am-4pm Wed-Sun Oct to Apr & 7 days a week May to Sep.
- 3 Serious Coffee at 230 Cook St**
Serious Coffee roasts fair-trade beans purchased from around the world. Sample their unique latte creations that reflect the changing seasons!

Fantastico by name, this café roasts their own beans, offers bistro-inspired bites, and a selection of beers & wines.

BLOOMS

- A Government House at
1401 Rockland Ave**
Located in the heart of the historic Rockland neighborhood, the gardens feature native & exotic plants, dramatic rocky landscaping and beautiful views of Juan de Fuca Strait & Olympic Mountains.

- B Abkhazi Gardens at 1964 Fairfield Rd.**
Discover the romantic history of Abkhazi Gardens; dramatic displays of Japanese maples, hellebores, Himalayan lilies, cyclamen & Garry Oaks, a protected native species.
- C Victoria's Palm Tree House at
428 Kipling St**
Take a side trip to 428 Kipling St, home to 15 giant palm trees, each over 25 feet tall & 45 years old!
- D Beacon Hill Park**
Explore the beautifully landscaped alpine, rock & rose gardens. Meander paths & bridges, visit ponds & watch for the pair of Bald Eagles, the family of Great Blue Herons & the resident peacocks. With over 200 acres, there is a lot to explore!
- E Victoria's Hanging Baskets**
Victoria's blooming hanging baskets grace lampposts throughout the summer, a tradition dating back over 75 years!
